



The Alberta Summer Suzuki Institute is a one week summer music camp experience.

What does ASSI offer the participating student?

- All classes use the Suzuki method and philosophy to provide music instruction that is based on listening as well as reading.
- Students work with teachers from all over North America.
- Masterclasses offer each student an individual lesson every day.
- Students have group classes from the very beginning to build ensemble skills.
- Orchestra and chamber music ensembles for more advanced students.
- Kodaly and Musicianship classes.
- Fiddling and improvisation.
- Several concerts during the week offer students both solo and group performance opportunities.
- Faculty also perform in concerts.
- SAA1 approved teacher development classes are held concurrently with the student classes.
